2. Adjust the Gain of the selected amplifier:

Adjust the gain level by rotating the GAIN knob. A Rotate of clockwise will increase the gain and vice versa. Be flexible to try it until you get the right tone you like.

3. Adjust the Tone of the selected amplifier:

Once an amp model is selected, rotate the TONE knob to adjust the brightness of the amp. You will have a bright sound on clockwise rotation and a dark tone on anti-clockwise rotation.

4. Turning the Volume control:

To change the DC-15' s volume level, just turn the 'VOLUME' knob clockwise or counter clockwise. More clockwise rotating, more volume outputs, and vice versa. Note: Too loud sound will damage your hearing.

5. Using Modulation Effects:

Rotate the EFFECTS knob to choose the favorite you like from Chorus, Flanger, Phaser and Tremolo. You can select the effects by reading the scope changes showed on the panel.

6. Using Acoustic Space Simulation Effects:

Rotate the SPACE knob to choose between Delay and Reverb effects. You can select the effect by reading the scope changes showed on the panel.

7. Using the Rhythm Machine

DC-15 features a built-in rhythm system switch with up to 36 kinds of drum patterns*. You can choose any kinds of rhythm style and use it to help your playing and practice. Start the Beats Function by pressing the button ACTIVE, and the 'RHYTHM' LED indicator will light on simultaneously. If you want to turn it off, just press the button ACTIVE again.

NOTE: See 'List of the 36 -Rhythm Patterns'

(1) Select a rhythm pattern:

When the rhythm machine is activated, press the 'TURN' button lightly, you will find the 'RHYTHM', 'SPEED' and 'VOLUME' LED indicator get lighted alternately. When the 'RHYTHM' LED indicator is lighted on, you can press "+" or "-" to choose one of the 36 rhythm patterns which you like to practice with.

(2) Adjust the rhythm speed:

When the rhythm machine is activated, press the 'TURN' button lightly, you will find the 'RHYTHM', 'SPEED' and 'VOLUME' LED indicator get lighted alternately. When the 'SPEED' LED indicator is lighted on, press and hold "+" or "-" button, then the rhythm speed will be changed between 30 and 240. After you' ve get the speed you want, let your finger away from the "+" or "-" button, rhythm speed adjustment is done!

(3) Adjust the volume of the rhythm machine:

While the rhythm machine is working, press the 'TURN' button lightly, you will find the 'RHYTHM', 'SPEED' and 'VOLUME' LED indicator get lighted alternately. When the 'VOLUME' LED indicator is lighted on, press and hold "+" or "-" button to change the volume of the rhythm machine. Once you' ve get your desired volume level, release the "+" or "-" button, the adjustment for the rhythm volume is finished!



BASIC OPERATION

1. Select an Amplifier Model:

- 2) Clean: An original tone designed by WAVE-X, which is characterized by a mellow and full sound and suitable for the clean tone solo.
- 3) Tube Screamer: Models the famous TS9 overdrive pedal.
- 4) Blues Drive: Models the SD-1 overdrive pedal.
- 5) Crunch: Models MI Audio's Crunch Box distortion pedal.
- 6) Lead: A Lead tone designed by WAVE-X, which is characterized by a rich and modern sound.
- 7) Rhythm: A modern rhythm tone designed by WAVE-X, which is characterized by a strong and powerful rhythm sound.
- 8) Metal: Model the famous BOSS MT2-Metal Zone distortion pedal.
